

Late Shri Pralhad P Chhabria
(12.03.1930 – 05.05.2016)

Late Shri Pralhad P Chhabria, Founder President, Hope Foundation and Research Centre (Hope Foundation) and Founder Chairman, Finolex Group of Companies has been an inspiration to many. Despite having received only primary education, with his ingenuity and inventive business strategies, Shri Chhabria established the Finolex Group of Companies in 1958 and over the years built it into a well-known conglomerate.

He firmly believed that the future of our country depended on two critical aspects; quality education and women empowerment.

Shri Chhabria has been known for his philanthropic activities encompassing education, health care, religious and spiritual teachings. Through the educational divisions Finolex Academy of Management and Technology (FAMT) at Ratnagiri and the International Institute of Information Technology (I²IT) at Pune, he has established a number of scholarships, assistantships and awards for students who have displayed academic excellence but lack the financial opportunity to pursue their dreams.

MESSAGE FROM THE CHAIR



Ray of sunshine in a cloudy world

A 14 year old girl child Ms. Harshada Bhalshankar studying in Std. 9 was hit by a football while she was returning home from school. She is now suffering from severe cervical spine abscess with atlantoaxial dislocation and she has been advised to undergo Occipito Cervical (spine) Fixation Surgery. Her parents are financially very poor, the father is a rickshaw driver and the mother is a domestic helper. Hope Foundation partially assisted her with an amount of Rs. 50,000/- for undergoing this surgery and we wish her a speedy recovery.



Caring to change a person's life

Giving a little is better than not giving at all. Deepali is a 47-year-old single mother who lost her husband 15 years ago. She is in the ICU and is undergoing treatment for Ruptured Middle Cerebral Artery (MCA) Aneurysms. Hope Foundation supported her family and assisted her in partially covering her cost of treatment.

A BETTER VISION IS OUR RESPONSIBILITY



In association with the Moolani's Eye Care Centre, Pune, Hope Foundation conducts eye camps, eye surgeries with a focus on those which aim at reducing preventable blindness such as cataract, glaucoma, pterygium and corneal surgeries in young and old, also to include surgical procedures for underprivileged children and young adults such as squint, ptosis and refractive procedures in high refractive errors to help them to achieve a stable social and financial life. It also conducts medical camps like eye screening and general health check-up camps etc.

During the year 2023, the Moolani's Eye Care Centre (MECC) has undertaken cataract surgeries on 52 economically weak patients and a total amount of Rs. 5,42,000/- (Rupees Five Lacs Forty-Two Thousand Only) has been spent by the Hope Foundation for undertaking these cataract surgeries.

We express our sincere gratitude to M/s. Rij Engineering Private Limited for the contributions being made by way of Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) during the last several years to enable us undertake this noble activity on economically weak patients.


